Dear Parents/Carers, Students and Staff

It is important to note that we have had the first of our Functional Skills assessments taking place this week. These will continue over the last two weeks of term for many of our Hammersmith and Bakerloo students. However, the main topic to be discussed in today's newsletter will be COVID-19/coronavirus.

This is an unprecedented situation and it is difficult to predict how it will unfold over the coming weeks and months. Our primary focus, across both Centre Academy Schools, is the health and safety of our pupils and staff. We continue to monitor and follow official advice, which is being added to on a daily basis.

Given this, we would like to highlight the following: if your child develops a cough, cold or fever, he or she should be kept at home for 7 days. Any student who displays these symptoms at School will be isolated and sent home. The current advice is that the child should not be taken to their GP or hospital. Help and advice can be accessed by calling NHS-111.

We will continue to remind students onsite about the importance of good hygiene and the need to wash hands regularly. Tissues and sanitising gel are available in classrooms as well as around the building. We are also not planning any School visits or trips outside the local area.

As a reminder, should we need to close the School:

- Parents/carers will be contacted by telephone, should that call be missed, we will then contact by email.
- Updates will be sent by email and posted on the School's website.
- Should the School close for more than 2 days, work will be sent home to the student's school email account.
- Teachers will be available by email from 8:30 to 3:30 daily and, if possible, the office will be staffed.
