I also wanted to take the time this week to reiterate our rules regarding wearing masks in school. All staff and students – except those with an exemption – are required to wear masks in corridors. They are also required to wear them when social distancing is not possible (e.g. if they talking face to face in the yard at lunchtime or if a teacher is handing out work). Students do not have to wear masks when socially distanced in the yard or when sitting at their desk working – although some students and staff do choose to wear them at these times too.
