Dear Parents/Carers, Students & Staff.



Student Mental Health Survey




1. I feel safe and happy a school last week

2. I feel safe and happy at home last week






Good to see this result! However, our safeguarding team are keeping an eye out for those two who do not feel safe or happy at home.
