Mrs Escobar our Mental Health Practitioner will be here to talk to you about the therapy sessions she will be providing for Mental Health and Wellbeing. She provides the students with a safe place to talk about their wellbeing, as well as providing intervention and support to increase self-esteem.

Finally, our senior management team Mrs Gilbert Head of School, Mrs Whall, Mr Steward and Mrs Coleman will also be available to talk to parents if you so wish.
